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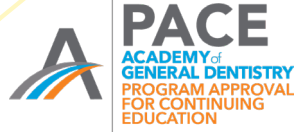

Summary

Day 1: Introduction to Equipment

Intensive day of model surgery on anatomic models featuring simulated soft tissue, bone topography, and anatomic landmarks. Treatment planning for posterior single tooth replacement.

Day 2: Demonstration Surgery

Each attendee to bring x-rays and models of their case. Group case discussion and treatment planning. Short lecture on surgical stents and surgical logistics. Demonstration Surgery.

Day 3: Surgery Day

Course attendees to perform surgery on their own patients with assistance from the mentor. Review of surgeries.

Day 4: Doctor and Staff Training

Rationale behind dental implants. Doctor and staff training (sterilization/setup/marketing). Staff recommended to attend lecture in the morning, followed by more surgeries and a review of the course.
