#### **Day 1: Introduction to Equipment**

#### **Day 2: Demonstration Surgery**

Each attendee to bring x-rays and models of their case. Group case discussion and treatment planning. Short lecture on surgical stents and surgical logistics. Demonstration Surgery.

#### Day 3: Surgery Day

Course attendees to perform surgery on their own patients with assistance from the mentor. Review of surgeries.

#### **Day 4: Doctor and Staff Training**

Rationale behind dental implants. Doctor and staff training (sterilization/setup/marketing). Staff recommended to attend lecture in the morning, followed by more surgeries and a review of the course.
