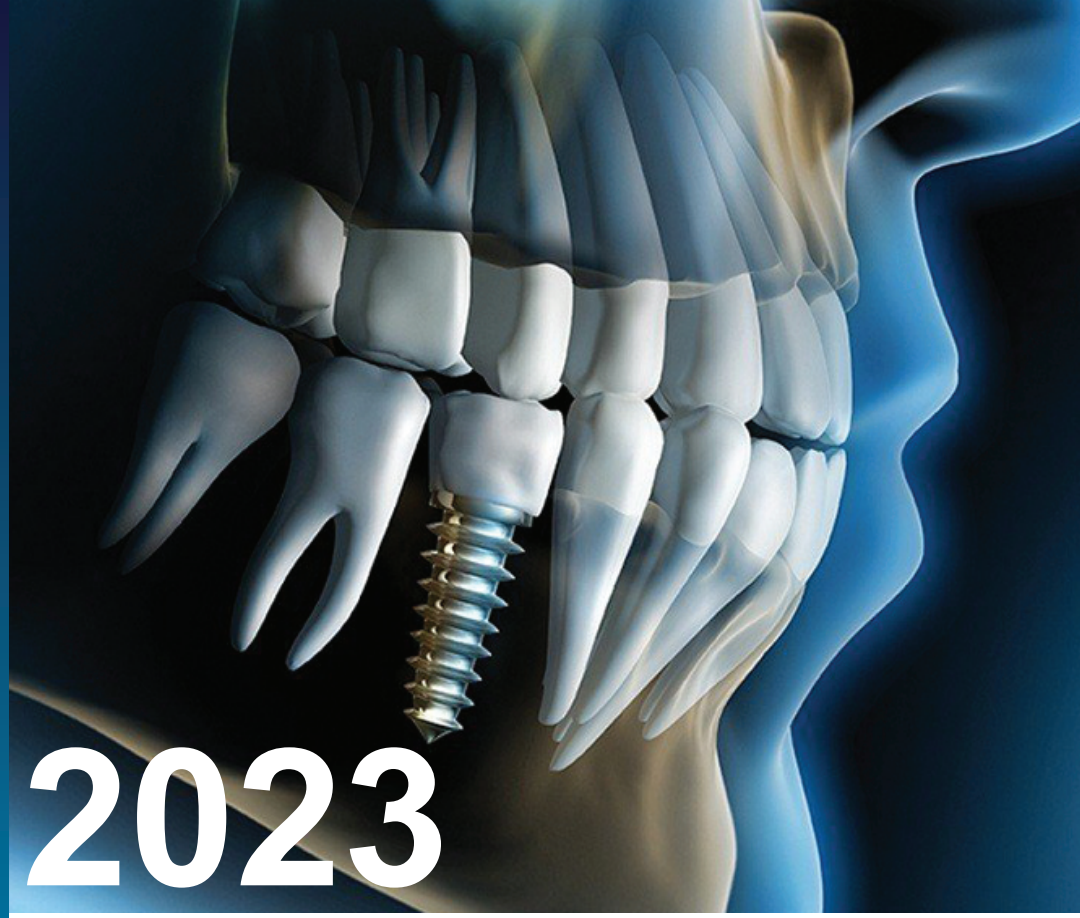

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This study club runs from January 2023 to December 2023. It includes 4 workshops encompassing 6.5 days and five evening seminars. Two of the workshops include assisted surgeries on your own patients with a specialist mentor. One workshop and one evening seminar include a hands-on portion on models. In addition, there is the opportunity to book mentor-assisted surgeries in Dr. Li's office. The program is for both the novice dentist and the advanced practitioner. Basic topics like bone grafting, extractions and implant prosthetics are included as are more advanced and cutting edge topics like full arch implant cases and advanced bone grafting techniques.

FULL DAY WORKSHOPS (9am - 4pm)

APRIL 14-15, 2023 (Friday & Saturday)

Dr. Mark Bishera :All on X - Full Arch Cases with Hands on

Dr. Mark Bishera is back with a program on full arch cases. He will be going through treatment planning and completing full arch cases with both guided and non-guided surgery. Removable options will also be discussed. The second day (Saturday) is a half day doing a hands on portion using the smile-in-a-box protocol. This is a much requested topic. Dr. Bishera offers a very organized program and was very well received last year when he spoke on socket shielding.

JUNE 23 & 24, 2023 (Friday & Saturday)

Dr. Sherif Said: Khoury Technique - Bone Grafting Review

Dr. Said is returning to give a program on soft tissue grafting with emphasis on soft tissue management around dental implant sites. The last few years, he has given a couple programs on advanced bone grafting techniques using tenting screws and the Khoury technique. He will review these at your request. The second day is for assisted surgery. Soft tissue cases along with bone grafting cases (as long as you have attended the previous Dr. Said programs) will be accepted.

OCTOBER 20 & 21, 2023(Friday & Saturday)

Dr. Amar Taimish : Removing Impacted Wisdom Teeth, Difficult Extractions, and Bone Grafting

Dr. Taimish is a highly requested speaker on this popular topic. The first day is didactic to be divided between the two topics. The first half will be removing impacted wisdom teeth and techniques for other difficult extractions. The second half of the day will be on bone grafting. The next day is for assisted surgeries for extractions or bone grafting cases.

NOVEMBER 18 , 2023 (Saturday)

Dr. Tim Hess : Dental Implants: Current Concepts, Concerns, & Complications

Dr. Hess is director of education for Washington State Academy of General Dentistry. Dental implant complications are more common than we'd like to see and this is always a popular topic. Please come with questions regarding your cases that did not go ideally.

EVENING SEMINARS (6pm - 9pm)

March 7, 2023 (Tuesday)

Dr. Frederick Li : Basic Implant Prosthetics with Complications

This program will be more than open tray versus closed tray. Digital impressions, tips on inserts, fixed versus cement-retained and complications will all be discussed.

MAY 16, 2023 (Tuesday)

Dr. Dr. Frederick Li: Basic Lateral Bone Grafting and Socket Grafting

Often, keeping things simple is the best way to treat a case. Learn basic lateral bone grafting and socket grafting. We have had plenty of speakers on advanced bone grafting techniques but as we add more components and complex techniques to each case, failures can become even more spectacular.

Dr. Raj Virk: Zero Bone Loss Concept (not confirmed) and Case Presentations

NOVEMBER 7, 2023 (Tuesday)

Dr. Jim Armstrong : Current Trends and the Economic Outlook for Dentistry.
